<u>Guidelines</u>: Choose a likely chimney. Observe and count all swifts that enter the chimney starting about 30 minutes prior to sunset until 10 minutes after the last swift has entered. Count any evening from early August in Northern Wisconsin to mid- to late September in southern Wisconsin.
